## New West End Synagogue, London Shabbat 30 March 2024

The New West End Synagogue was established in 1879. The first Minister was the Reverend Simeon Singer, who compiled the first daily Prayer Book to be used throughout the English-speaking world; over time it became known as the Authorised Prayer Book, the "Singer", which is still in use to this day, many editions later. The first Director of Music, Mr DM Davis, compiled the equivalent tome for liturgical music, known as "the Blue Book", which too is the foundation for the Minhag Anglia service melodies. The Synagogue today preserves and enhances this musical tradition with a full-time choir accompanying services every Sabbath and Festival
